We certify that the violin, illustrated on the reverse side of this document, is a modern Italian violin, in our judgement made by a violinmaker unknown to us from the circle of influence of Mario Gadda in Porto Mantovano and dateable to c.1970. The violin currently bears an apocryphal label of Stefano Scarampella in Mantova, dated 1906.

Description:

The back consists of two pieces of maple, cut on the quarter, with a somewhat irregular medium width figure that descends from the center joint. The ribs and scroll are of maple with a narrower and more regular flame pattern when compared to the back. The belly is of two symmetric pieces of spruce with an annual ring spacing of a mostly medium-narrow width. The varnish is of a deep red-orange color over a golden yellow ground coat. This violin is a characteristic example of the production of the entourage of Mario Gadda for the period.
