I certify, that this violin is entirely made by myself in 2008 after an outline of Antonio Stradivari, Cremona.

It bears a label:

Marcus Klimke Angers Anno 2008

The back is made in two pieces of Balkan maple, with medium and a bit larger distance of "wild" growth, which is unevenly spaced. It has rather deep medium flames of a bit different widths, which are unevenly spaced. The flames are going up from the outside towards the joint. It is quartercut and has quite many medium sized "rose flecks".

The ribs and the neck are made from a similar wood.

The belly is made from two pieces of spruce from northern Italy with many "flecks". It has a medium to a bit larger distance of growth which is also there unevenly spaced. It is "wilder" on the lower right bout.

The instrument is protected with an oil based varnish of yellow-red-brown color, put on a yellow-golden ground. The whole appearence is the impression of an a bit older and already played instrument.
