Description:

The two piece top is made of spruce with fine to medium width grain. The two piece back is made of flamed maple with narrow width figure, descending from the center joint. The maple ribs of broader figured maple. The varnish is of an intense golden-orange color applied on a golden-yellow ground. All major parts of the violin presented here are the originals and the instrument has been kept in good condition which reflects its age.
